

Migration in Gender and Generation Highlights of the Research Findings

Before marriage: be self-reliant and save to marry, After marriage: take responsibility for wife, children and support ageing parents


The Gender Dynamics in Migrant Households








Misuse of remittances encourage migrant women to re-migrate, divorce and seeking justice through the courts
